# School Improvement Grant

## Progress towards Expectations

- **Progress is being made towards meeting leading indicator goals of the grant and milestones have been reviewed**
  - *Members of the DLT met with the SIG principals to review criteria for annual renewal of the grant*
  - *SIG principals and School Improvement Specialist will meet with MDE representatives in January to discuss revisions and/or updates to the leading indicator goals*
- **MDE site visit and SIG school data presentations were conducted on November 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>**
  - *Data presentations were conducted by all three SIG principals in central office boardroom*
  - *The new SIG coach met with each principal at their school to discuss some expectations for the remainder of the year*
  - *The new SIG coach attended PLC's, conducted classroom observations and participated in a learning walk at Threadgill Elementary on December 6<sup>th</sup>.*
  - *Next visit will be in January (visits will be conducted at least once a month and on a "as needed" basis.*
- **Monthly / Bi-monthly meetings with SLT (school leadership teams) and DLT (district leadership team) have been conducted**

# School Improvement Grant December Highlights

- Threadgill Elementary School has 78% of all 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math students meeting growth expectations.
- Greenwood Middle School has 62% of all 7<sup>th</sup> grade math students scoring proficient or advance.
- Greenwood High School has 63% of all Algebra I students scoring proficient or advance.
