School Improvement Grant

Progress towards Expectations

- **Progress is being made towards meeting leading indicator goals of the grant and milestones have been reviewed**
 - *Members of the DLT met with the SIG principals to review criteria for annual renewal of the grant and budget expenditure requirements*
 - *Follow-up meeting with SIG principals will be held the 3rd week of January.*
 - *SIG principals and School Improvement Specialist will meet with MDE representatives in January to discuss revisions and/or updates to the leading indicator goals*
- **MDE site visits were conducted on December 6th**
 - *A site visit was conducted at Threadgill Elementary School.*
 - *Site visit focus was observation, lesson planning and effective feedback.*
 - *Job-embedded PD was provided to the Threadgill faculty based on the feedback from the site visit.*
 - *Next visit will be in January (visits will be conducted at least once a month and on an “as needed” basis.*
- **Monthly / Bi-monthly meetings with SLT (school leadership teams) and DLT (district leadership team) will continue in the month of January**

School Improvement Grant

2nd Nine Week Assessment Highlights

- Threadgill Elementary School continues to show improvement with the number of students meeting growth in the bottom 25% in 5th grade Math.
- Greenwood Middle School has a 18% increase in students scoring proficient or advanced in 8th grade Science.
- Greenwood High School continues to show improvement with the number of students meeting growth in the bottom 25% in Algebra I.
