## School Improvement Grant Progress towards Expectations

- State Assessments were administered at each school from May 1<sup>st</sup> May 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Overall participation rate at Greenwood High School was 97% and an overall participation rate of 99% at Greenwood Middle School and Threadgill Elementary School
- School Improvement Grant Renewal Application for 2018-2019 school term was submitted May 25<sup>th</sup>.
  - Threadgill Elementary School and Greenwood Middle School had to meet 4 out of the 7 leading indicators as well as show progress towards meeting achievement indicators. (see next slide)
  - Greenwood High School had to meet 5 out of the 9 leading indicators as well as show progress towards meeting achievement indicators. (see next slide)
