School Improvement Grant

Progress towards Expectations

- **Progress is being made towards meeting leading indicator goals of the grant**
 - *Extended school has begun with about 250 students in attendance meeting on Tuesday and Thursday of each week from 3:35 p.m. to 5:35 p.m.*
 - *Average daily attendance is at or above 96% at each site*
- **Milestones have been reviewed**
 - *We are at step 5 in our RFP process beginning discussion with our external providers.*
- **MDE site visit conducted September 20th – 21st**
 - *The principals and members of the district leadership team were trained on the alignment of the 5 SIG components and the 8 turnaround principles.*
 - *Observations were conducted at Greenwood Middle School and Threadgill Elementary*
 - *Recommendations were made to the school administrators*
 - *Next visit will be October 24th & October 31st*
- **Monthly / Bi-monthly meetings with SLT (school leadership teams) and DLT (district leadership team) have been conducted**

School Improvement Grant October District Assessment Highlights

- Threadgill Elementary School - 48% scored Proficient & Advance in 5th grade Science
- Greenwood Middle School - 19% increase in proficiency in 8th grade Science
- Greenwood High School – 54% scored Proficient & Advance in U.S. History
